




And while the bidding is fun, his favorite part of any auction is that moment when the crowd comes together to help change the world – also known as the fund-a-need.

Greg and his wife live in San Francisco with their son, Ryder, who sold his first auction lot when he was just four.



The French Connection

A WEEK IN FRANCE

*5 nights at Le Château de Boismorand for 4

A man's home is his castle, but castles are literally Dario Sattui's homes. Enjoy a stay at his most recent find.

After researching more than 1,200 French castles, Dario Sattui found his dream site: a castle built in the 1300s and now designated a national monument, four hours southwest of Paris: Le Château de Boismorand.

And you can call it home for five glorious days. Located on 80 acres overlooking La Gartempe River and the surrounding countryside, the castle itself is 20,000 square feet with additional outbuildings. It includes 30 rooms, 12-foot-high carved stone fireplaces, stained glass windows, painted ceilings, beautiful woodwork throughout, and a 500-year-old frescoed chapel, all surrounded by formal French gardens.

But this taste of history includes modern creature comforts, as well: your accommodations are two large bedrooms, each with private bath, with access to the living room, dining room, billiards room, large modern kitchen (where you can prepare meals if you choose to eat in), tennis court, sauna, and a canoe for exploring the river. An English-speaking caretaker is also on site.

If you choose to explore beyond the castle, there are medieval villages—including a UNESCO site, San Savin—nearby, as well as other castles and excellent restaurants.

After your stay, you'll head to the Dordogne region, where you'll enjoy a two-night stay in two rooms at Belle Etoile Hotel near the medieval city of Sarlat, and dinner for four each night. Explore the medieval stone villages, the region's wine offerings, or the surrounding sites, such as the city of Périgueux and its Cathédrale Saint Front, the caves and prehistoric area of the Vézère valley; or some of the region's castles.

You'll live like French royalty, if just for a few days.



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


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
